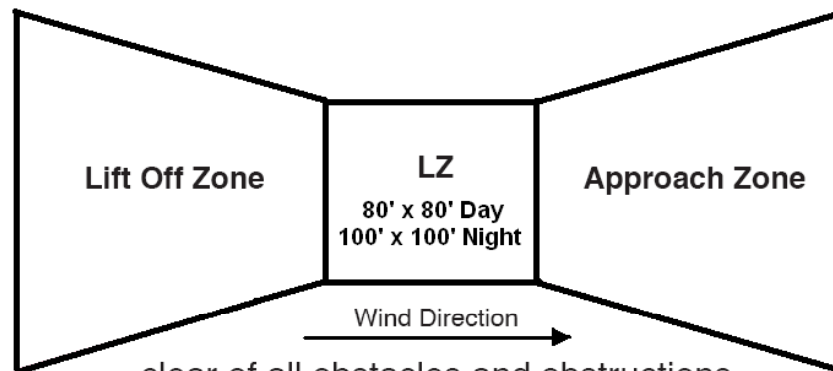

### **HAZARDS TO WATCH FOR & NOTIFY THE FLIGHT TEAM**

- ➡ Obstructions: Trees, Telephone Poles, Antennas  
Powerlines/Wires (If able, spotlight poles)
- ➡ Obstacles: Loose Debris, Signs, Livestock, Bystanders
- ➡ Wires & Wind: Direction & Speed

When in Doubt, Point it Out!!
