Regional West's Wound/Ostomy Clinic has treated the region's wound patients since 2009 and is dedicated to providing superior care for patients with a variety of wounds. Following a thorough diagnostic appraisal of the wound, our Wound Clinic physicians, providers, and nurses develop a comprehensive wound treatment plan customized for each patient, and manage subsequent wound treatment as needed. The patient's primary care provider continues to manage the patient's needs, including pain management, diabetes, blood pressure, etc.

Referred conditions include, but are not limited to:

- Diabetic foot ulcers
- Pressure ulcers
- Acute wounds
- Chronic non-healing wounds
- Venous stasis ulcers
- Arterial ulcers
- Peri-stomal complications
- Burns
- Wound vac dressing changes
- Non-healing surgical wounds

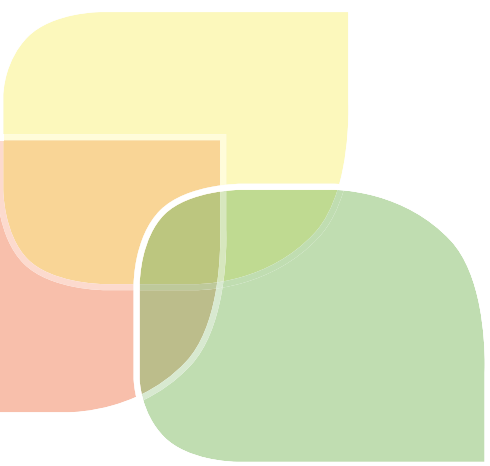
Services offered include:

- Education and recommendations for dressings
- Conservative sharp wound debridement
- Nutrition education and its impact on wound healing
- Education on how blood sugars can affect wound healing
- Specialized wraps and stockings to promote wound healing and swelling management
- Treatment with advanced wound care products
- Total contact casts
- Wound vac therapy management
- Management of topical medications used to treat wounds
- Specialized training related to colostomy, ileostomy, and urostomy
- Peri-skin tube site management
- Management of skin damage related to moisture
- Smoking cessation education

Referring a patient to the Wound/Ostomy Clinic:

Via Cerner, the healthcare provider puts an order in “Wound Clinic InitialVisit” and selects “Yes” for a future visit. Providers outside Cerner need to fax the healthcare provider’s order to Regional West’s OneCall at 308-630-1503. Once the referral is processed, the patient will be scheduled by Wound Clinic staff.

- Patient’s legal name
- Patient’s date of birth (DOB)
- Patient’s contact information (Phone numbers where he or she can be reached)
- Procedure and medical necessity (i.e. non-healing right lower extremity wound, schedule for wound clinic consultation)
- Name of ordering healthcare provider

Note: For our patients’ safety during scheduled appointments, nursing home residents must be accompanied by a staff or family member. If the resident is not accompanied, then the appointment will be rescheduled for a time when someone is available to attend the appointment with him/her.
